I am writing to express my opposition to the application by Baryonyx Corporation for a 500 turbine wind farm in the Gulf of Mexico state waters. This application does not evaluate or even address the tremendous negative impact that this large wind farm could have on the millions of birds from through out the Northern Hemisphere who migrate through the project area. There is no doubt that threatened and endangered species will be negatively affected by the development of this wind farm.

Any applicant for a project with such potential for a large negative effect on bird populations should be required to prepare a full Environmental Impact Statement.

The comment period for this application should be extended from 30 to 90 days as this project has the potential to affect species of birds that nest through out North America and it is important that all conservation organizations, government agencies and private citizens with interests in these species have an opportunity to comment on this project.

I ask that at least two public hearings to collect information about the potential impacts of this project be held on the Texas Coast as the geographic area impacted by this project is large.
