In the 1980s, Houston Audubon first took action to protect Bolivar Flats, located across the Galveston Ferry on Bolivar Peninsula on the Texas Gulf Coast. Since that time, we have secured 1,240 acres of this critical migratory shorebird habitat.

The last missing piece, part of this designated “Globally Important Bird Area”, is under a tight **final purchase deadline (12/31/25) to raise \$3 million** to prevent the already planned and platted development.
