How and WHERE do I recycle this thing?

One of the greatest ways we can contribute to the successful recycling of materials is by knowing what materials can be recycled and where, as well as how to properly recycle things you can put in curbside as well as household hazardous materials (HHM), automotive waste like oil and batteries, and electronics.
